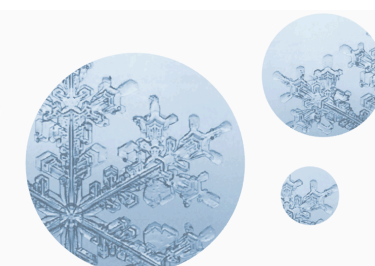

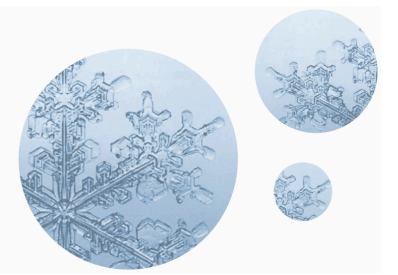

How to get to the meeting venue from the city centre

Transport Mode	Route / Lines	Approx. Travel Time	Cost
Metro (Recommended)	L1 (Red Line) → Stop: <i>Hospital de Bellvitge</i>	~25 min from Plaça Catalunya + 8–10 min walk	€2.65 (standard fare)
Bus	Several lines: L70, L72, L80, L86, L94 ; also 65 from Plaça Espanya to Hospital de Bellvitge	35–50 min depending on route and traffic	€2.65
Taxi	Door-to-door	15–20 minutes from city centre	€20–€30

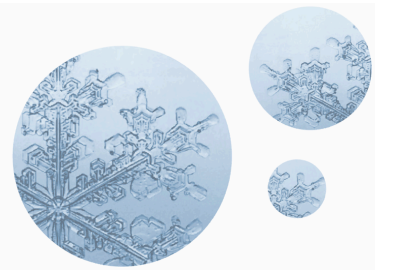

Gaudí's iconic masterpiece and Barcelona's most famous landmark. Absolutely unmissable.



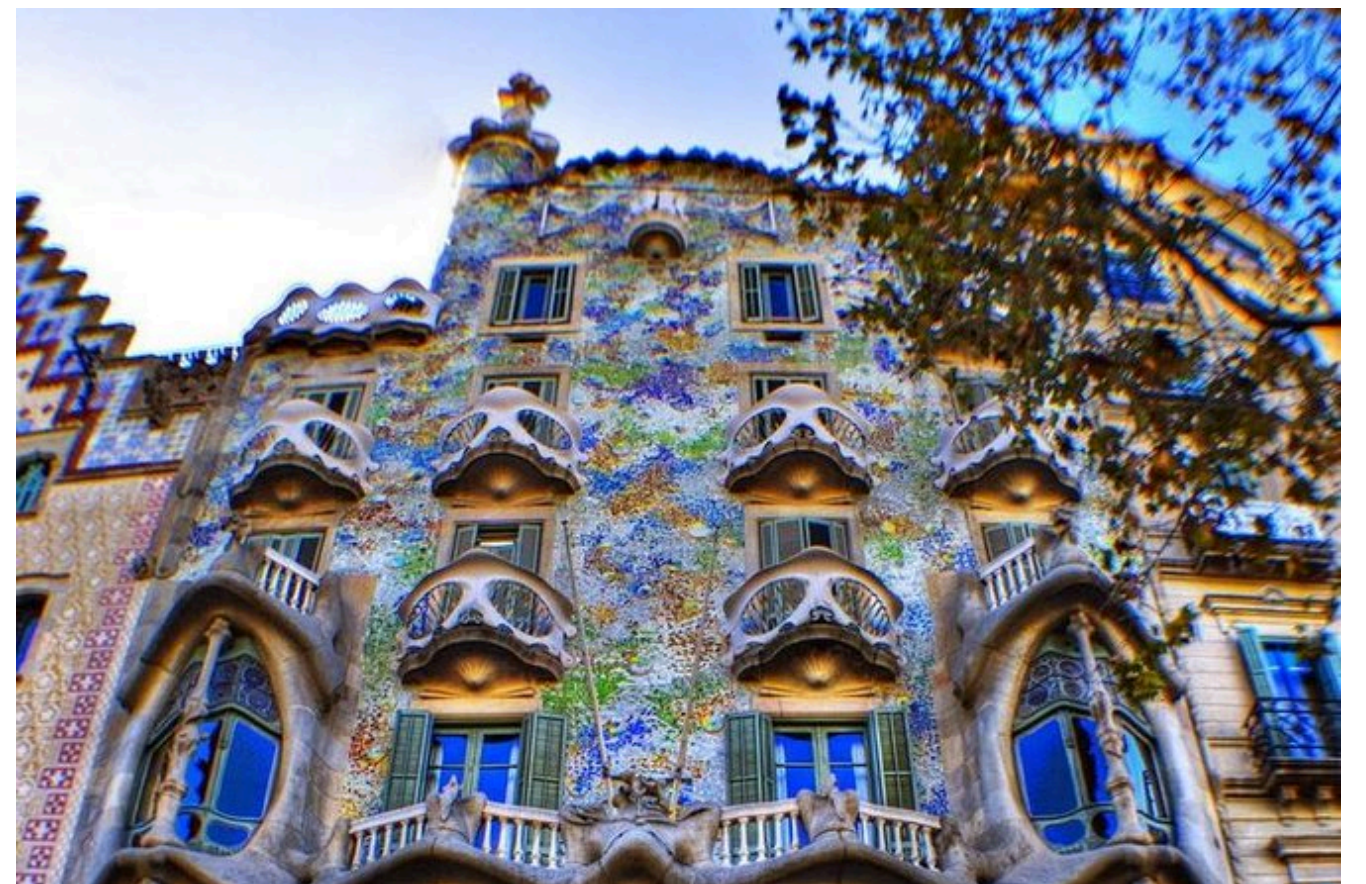
Park Güell

Gaudí's imaginative residential masterpieces featuring organic shapes, vivid colors, and remarkable rooftop designs.



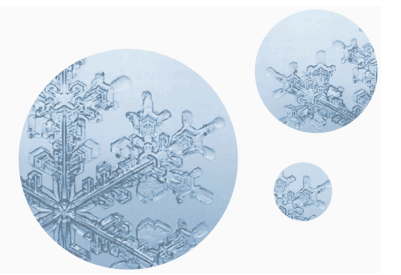
Montjuïc | Cable Car and Views
